MRM er en førende forsker i krydsfeltet mellem international og transnational ret, politik og samfund. Hans unikke tilgang, som kombinerer juridiske, humanistiske og samfundsvidenskabelige metoder, har ført til banebrydende forskning inden for international ret, retssociologi og politisk sociologi. MRM har 223 forskningspublikationer registreret ved Københavns Universitet, herunder 9 monografier og antologier samt 81 tidsskriftsartikler. Han har publiceret i førende tidsskrifter inden for flere akademiske felter: jura (*International Journal of Constitutional Law* og *European Journal of International Law*), statskundskab (*American Political Science Review*), sociologi (*International Political Sociology*) og retssociologi (*Law & Social Inquiry*). **Academic and entrepreneurial focus:** We investigate how glycans impinge on cells during tissue development and cancer growth, and how to exploit this for early detection and treatment of disease with an emphasis on cancer targeting. We explore and map glycogenes with new enzymatic technologies to turn genes on and off, identify new disease causes, and establish how glycans influence protein function. In addition, we seek to develop new methods to investigate what changes these infer on the glycome and cellular processes using novel mass spec technologies and seek to translate our findings into practical solutions for improved therapies and diagnostics.
